





 Cultural heritage: a group of resources inherited from the past which people identify [...] as a reflection and expression of their constantly evolving values, beliefs, knowledge and traditions



• A heritage community: people who value specific aspects of cultural heritage which they wish, within the framework of public action, to sustain and transmit to future generations.
